

Open call: Access Crash Course at auawirleben 2025

This year's <u>auawirleben Theaterfestival Bern</u> (7 to 18 May) was co-curated by Dan Daw and Liz Counsell from <u>Dan Daw Creative Projects</u>. We are taking the presence of these two accessibility experts as an opportunity to offer a workshop for Swiss theatre and dance professionals. The one-week workshop during the festival will provide practical instructions and hands-on tips on how theatre and dance productions can be made more accessible to audiences.

Programme: Workshops: with various experts on basics, funding opportunities, sign language interpretation & Deaf culture, audio description & touch tours, relaxed performances & pre-show access
Sign language lessons: daily lesson of one hour
One week of festival programme: 9 performances, some of which involve accessibility measures, a documentary film on access work, a panel discussion, two events in the supporting programme at the Festival Centre with a focus on accessibility
Exchange with Dan Daw Creative Projects and the auawirleben team

Dates: Sun 11 May (noon) to Sat 17 May (afternoon)

- What we offer: Theatre tickets, accommodation, travel expenses, per diems, discount at the Festival Centre, workshops with summary handouts
- **Open to:** A maximum of 10 theatre and dance professionals from Switzerland, with or without experience in accessibility. The workshop will be held in English.
