The programme includes productions from the independent scene as well as from city theatres. auawirleben's very open notion of theatre also includes dance, installations, performance art or trans-disciplinary formats. The structuring element of the programme is the annually changing festival theme. auawirleben 2026 will take place from 6-17 May.
